NOTIFICATION OF BIENNIAL MEETING 2020 (postponed to 2022 due to COVID-19)

This notice serves to confirm that the next Biennial Meeting of the IBGA will take place remotely (online platform to be confirmed) on Sunday 3rd April 2022 at 12.00 GMT.

Members are reminded of the following clauses in the IBGA constitution:

Clause 6.3:

Written notice of propositions to change the Constitution must be received by the Vice-Chairman/Administration no less than ninety (90) days prior to the Biennial Meeting (i.e. no later than 12.00 GMT on 3 January 2022).

Clause 7.8:

Non-constitutional propositions for consideration at the Biennial Meeting must be received by the Vice-Chairman/Administration no less than forty-five (45) days prior to the Biennial Meeting (i.e. no later than 12.00 GMT on 17 February 2022).

Clauses 7.5 & 7.6:

Each National Association shall be entitled to one representative at the Biennial Meeting.

The name of the Representative of the National Association must be received by the Vice-Chairman/Administration no less than forty-five days before the Biennial Meeting.

Clauses 5.4 & 5.12:

Three directors shall retire at the Biennial Meeting.

Any nominee for election as Director must be a member of the nominating National Member. Nominations must be received by the Vice-Chairman/Administration no less than forty-five (45) days prior to the date of the Biennial Meeting.

The directors retiring at the coming Biennial Meeting are:

- John Eakin;
- Gerry Nelson; and
- Linda Port.

Retiring Directors may be nominated for re-election by their National Associations.

In addition to John White (representing (Dr Handa), Andrea Calcaterra, Graham Coulton and Garrett Slattery remain on the Board of Directors until the following Biennial Meeting – which is intended to be held in 2023 (at the time of the postponed 2020 World Championships).
