

2019 ISPS HANDA Japan Blind Golf Open

INFORMATION

Japanese Blind Golf Association will host the 2019 Japan Blind Golf Open on September 18th and 19th at Hakonekohan Golf Course. The course is located in Hakone, a comfortable tourist destination near Mt. Fuji.

Event

This will be a 36 hole Stroke play event played over two days. This is open to all players with an IBGA handicap and will follow the 2019 R&A revised rules of golf and related modifications.

Players with an exact handicap higher than the maximum allowed for each sight category can play in a 2 day Stableford competition.

Prizes

In accordance with IBGA requirements.

Entry Fee

JPY20,000 or US\$200.

This will include dinner, bed and breakfast for each player and aide/guide from dinner on Monday 16th September to breakfast on Friday 20th September.

Players and participants will be responsible for any additional costs.
